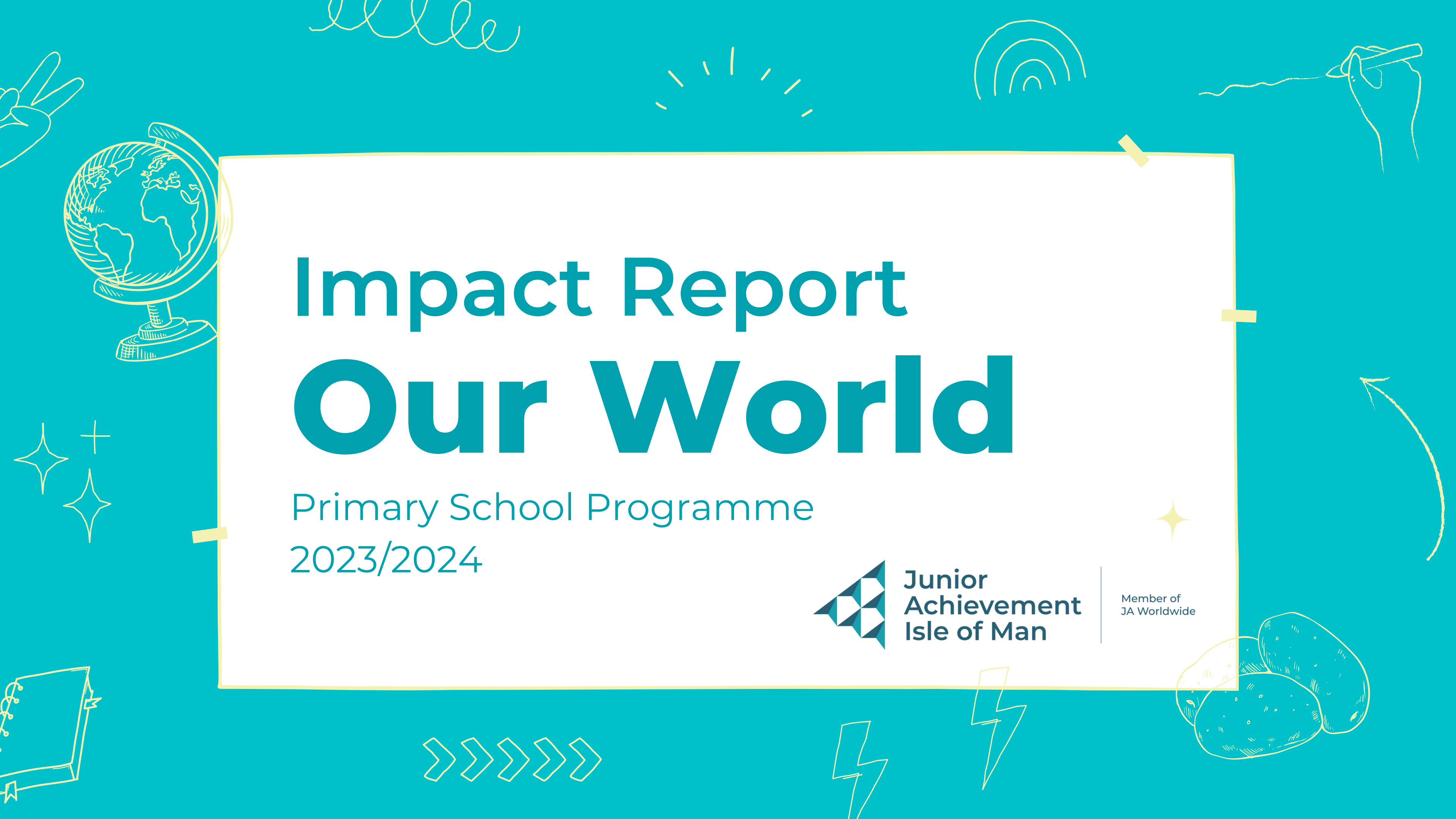

Introduction

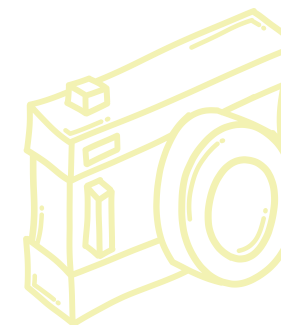
"Our World" is our JA Isle of Man programme designed for students of primary school age between 9 and 11 years.

In this programme two members of the JA Team, along with one or two volunteers, visit a class of primary pupils.

Students discover that businesses trade on a worldwide scale. They are introduced to the complexities of global trade between countries at different levels of economic development and the available resources at their disposal.

The Our World programme helps the students to develop a range of soft skills, including creativity, communication and organisational skills. It also helps build their confidence by encouraging students to present their ideas to the rest of the class.

Before joining JA Isle of Man, **Rachel** worked for eight years in the Life Assurance Industry.

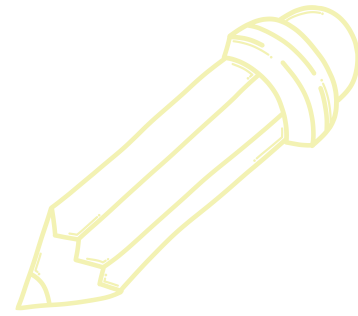
After the birth of her second child, Rachel became a full-time mother, giving her a new perspective on children's education and finding fun ways to help them learn at home.

Footprint



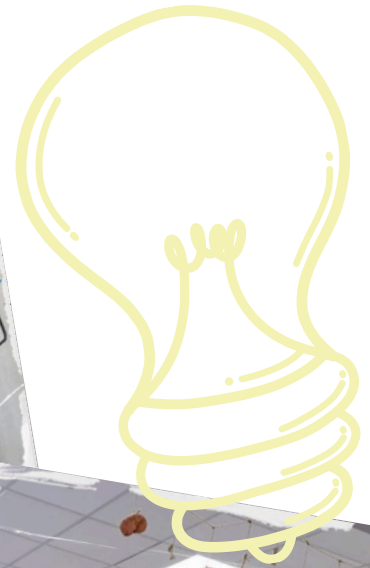
999 Students participated in the programme.

Primary Teachers Feedback

96% of the primary teachers agreed that the Our World Programme encourages the students to work with other students outside of their friendship groups.

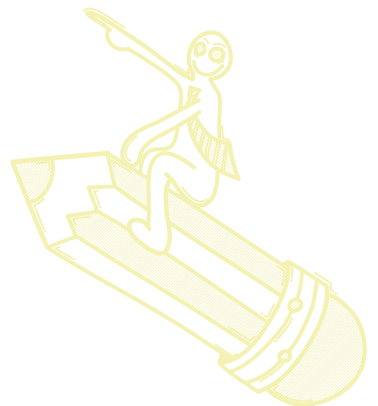

The Trading Game

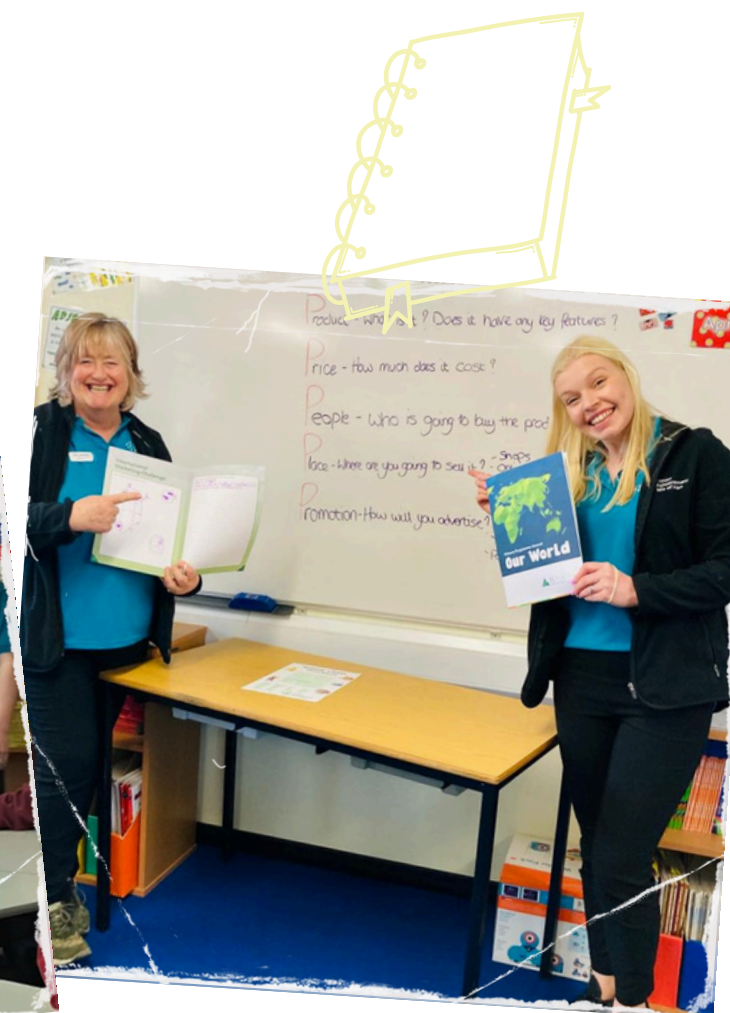


Learning by doing:
