Our programmes

OUR WORLD (10 - 11 Years)

This is a one day programme where students learn about global trading and the world around them.

ENTERPRISE CHALLENGE (11 - 13 Years)

This half day programme gives students the opportunity to plan and organise a pop concert working in teams.

LEARN TO EARN (13 - 14 Years)

This one day programme helps students to develop skills for the workplace and to identify what type of job they might be suited to.

IT'S ALL ABOUT MONEY (14 - 16 years)

Run over half a day, this important programme teaches students the importance of money management.

GET A JOB (14 - 16 years)

Helps students to understand the recruitment and selection process used by employers with a view to increasing their chances of getting a job.

INTERVIEW WORKSHOP (15 -16 years)

This programme involves employers from different industries going into school and offering students the chance to have a mock interview against a real job description.

COMPANY PROGRAMME (16 - 17 years)

Students set up and run their own business over the course of an academic year supported by Volunteer Business Mentors. This programme runs from September to April for one hour per week during term time.

What we do

Junior Achievement is the Island's leading educational charity reaching more than 5,500 young people in primary and secondary schools here on the Isle of Man.

How it works

No previous teaching experience is required. If you are confident, committed and passionate about helping young people to succeed we want to hear from you.

Junior Achievement will provide you with the training and the materials you need. Volunteers work in pairs in the classroom. A teacher is always present.

Time commitment

Volunteers have complete control over how many hours they would like to give and how many times they would like to volunteer each year.

Volunteering takes place during school hours and you can choose which school and which age group you would like to work with.

Junior Achievement school programmes last between 4 - 7 hours. In addition to this there will be some time spent prior to the programme for training and preparation.
